


ARTIST INFORMATION SHEET



- Artists may use either acrylic or oil paint
- Painting should depict "Life in the Swannanoa Valley." This can be landscape, landmarks, buildings, nature, or area living/lifestyle.
- The Committee will be responsible for weather proofing your work. (not the artist.)
- PLEASE KEEP IN MIND:
- -> These art boards will be weatherproofed (polyurethane coating) before being mounted on rockers. So, try to avoid heavy/thick clumps or strokes of paint if possible (as they may be chipped/worn off during the season of use.)
- -> Be sure to have art board COMPLETELY dried before turning into the Chamber (especially important with oil paintings.)
- -> "Live area" should keep in mind the top and bottom edges, as there will be mounting holes drilled on these sides (approx. 1" from edge)
